**a) Qualifications**

- Experienced diver in fresh water, low visibility conditions; 150+ dives preferred.
- Certification as an active Dive Master or Instructor from an internationally recognized certifying agency.
- Training and experience as a lead scientific diver, a plus.
- Membership in the American Academy of Underwater Sciences (AAUS) preferred.
- Ability to organize, lead, motivate, and supervise a team of 35 divers.
- Ability to formulate and implement a dive procedure and safety manual following OSHA and AAUS standards.

**b) Duties and Responsibilities**

- The Diving Safety Officer (DSO) oversees routine diver operations for the Skaneateles Lake Eurasian Milfoil Eradication Corporation (SLMEC), including conduct of training and certification, approval of dive plans, maintenance of diving records, and ensuring compliance with program standards defined in the SLMEC Dive Safety Manual.
- The DSO reports to the SLMEC Project Manager who coordinates all boating, diving, and milfoil removal operations.
- The Diving Safety Officer serves as an ex-officio member of the Dive Control subcommittee of the Skaneateles Lake Eurasian Milfoil Eradication Corporation Board of Directors.
